Mix it up: topping ideas! For the topping of this watermelon salad, we've called for chopped basil, lemon zest, and some sea salt. But you can get as creative as you'd like! Here are some ideas: **Herbs.** Use a different herb like mint or oregano. **Pepper or olive oil:** You can even top with fresh ground pepper, or add a drizzle of olive oil. **Other citrus:** If you'd like it tangier, add more lemon juice — or go with lime zest instead!

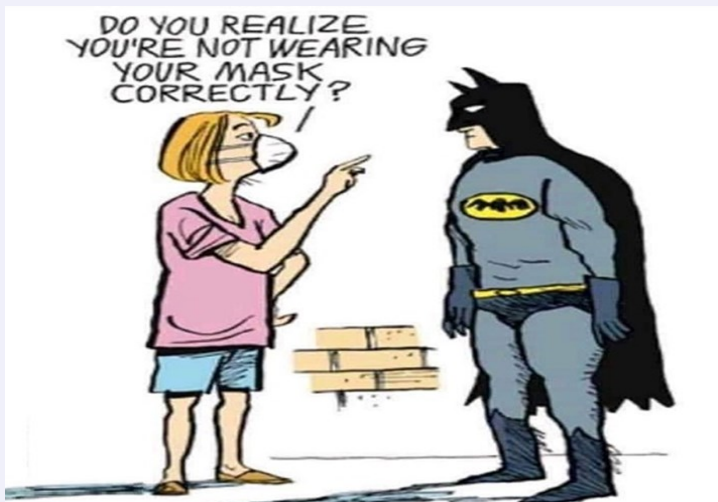
MR. C's CORNER:

How do I apply: Contact your Community Manager for an application.



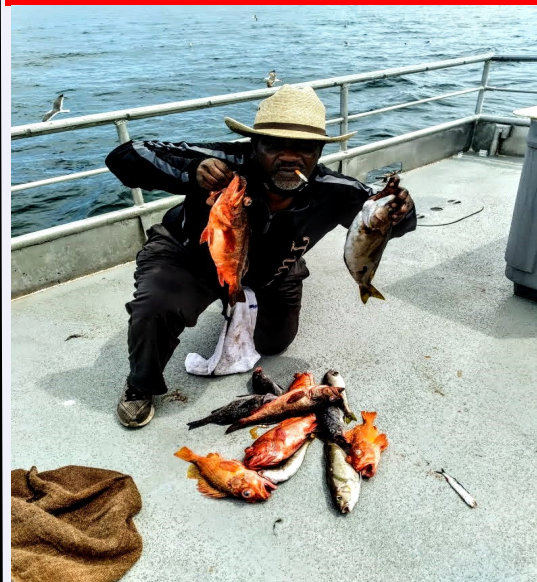
