Yes Yes Yes.....It's Pumpkin Time Again !!! Easy Two Ingredient Pumpkin Bread



STEP BY STEP DIRECTIONS:

1. COMBINE INGREDIENTS
2. PREPARE A BAKING PAN WITH PAM SPRAY OR BAKING SHEETS
3. BAKE IN AN OVEN FOR 35 TO 40 MINUTES @ 350 DEGREES

- ◆ Insert a toothpick into the center of the bread. If the toothpick comes out clean or with only a few crumbs clinging to it, it's safe to remove the bread from the oven to a cooling rack.
- ◆ Another method to use is to lightly touch (quickly/don't burn yourself) the center of the bread. If the bread feels springy, it's done. If you notice that your finger made an indentation in the center of the bread that is remaining, let the bread bake for a few more minutes.

You will Need:

- (1) box Spice cake Mix
- (1) small can of pumpkin (not pie filler)

How Soon after COVID-19 Exposure Should I Get Tested?

Note: Fully vaccinated people without symptoms do not need to get tested, but should still monitor for symptoms for 14 days following an exposure.

Exposed to COVID-19?



You may want to get tested...



But don't get tested too soon! Your result may not be accurate.



Wait 5-7 days after being exposed to COVID-19 to get tested.



While you wait to get tested, quarantine at home and stay away from others.



After testing, quarantine at home and stay away from others while awaiting results.



It is safest to quarantine for a total of 14 days, but if staying home would pose a significant economic hardship or burden, and if your test is negative, quarantine can end after 7 days.
