Congratulations!!!, you got notified you just won millions of dollars and a new luxury car. The caller can sure make the win feel so real. Most people hear this, forget their common sense and rush into the excitement of emotions and are pushed on by the caller, to answer questions like; how are you going to spend the money & where are you going to drive the brand-new car. Only one little problem, while the winner is focusing on their good luck, they get a message that they have to pay some kind of government fee first. YOU BETTER WAKE UP FAST – you are being taken- conned – you never won anything – they are just after the large, stated fee – IT IS A SCAM. Hang up fast.

<u>Try this one</u>. You get a phone call, a family member, or a name you know, is in some type of trouble or has a problem & needs your help. The story details are very emotional but end up with you having to send money right away or if you do not, something bad is going to happen to them. **Don't jump at this request from a stranger & feel guilty.** Hang up fast. - this is a scam. (Scams & con calls come in many forms. So do the ways to pay them.)

To stop all types of scams on all ages, you should not answer a phone call of an out of the area phone number that you do not know. These scam & con organizations are so good, they can dial your phone number & have their phone number show up on your phone, as a local area code & phone number, even if the call originated from South Africa or somewhere else in the world.

Absolutely no federal agency will ever "cold call" you to discuss your personal identifying information. Beware of the Scammers Out There.
