IF YOU EARNED UNDER \$60,000 IN 2022, YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR

TAX PREPARATION & FILING

AND YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR STATE AND FEDERAL EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT. Self-employed workers, families and those with ITINs earning up to \$30,000 are eligible for the CalEITC.

Free tax preparation assistance begins February 1 and continues through April 30.

IN PERSON

In-person tax preparation assistance is available by appointment only. Schedule your appointment at MyFreeTaxes.org or by calling 2-1-1.

SECURE DROP-OFF

For assistance completing your taxes without an appointment, drop off an envelope with copies of your tax documents at the front desk or in the secure mailbox at one of the following locations:

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO PREPARE YOUR RETURN:

- Social Security card or ITIN for each family member
- x W-2 forms for all jobs worked in 2022
- ¤ All 1099 forms for other income
- ¤ Picture ID for each adult filing taxes
- 🕱 2021 tax return
- ¤ Cancelled check for direct deposit of tax refund
- ¤ Childcare provider information: name, address, and Tax ID number (if available)
- ¤ Form 1095-A (Covered CA) if applicable
- ¤ Form 3895 (Covered CA) if applicable

ADDITIONAL FORMS NEEDED WITH DROP-OFF (AVAILABLE AT FRONT DESK):

- ø Form 13614 Intake/Interview
- Form 14446 Virtual Consent
- Selfie of taxpayer holding picture ID to verify identity

JOSE S. @ **MOUTAINVIEW**



I was born and raised in Santa Paula and grew up around big families, but broken families. We grew up on welfare, I had to start working at a young age to help the household. But with that stress I started drinking at a young age. The difficulties in my family led to me becoming an alcoholic. I have been in and out of programs for my addictions. I sobered up for 12 years and was working at Salvation Army but was laid off and went back to drinking and returned to the streets and had to survive. I was in and out of sobriety, bouncing from homelessness, jail, and different programs. My most recent homelessness I got connected to Mercy House and was there for 2.5 years and in August I will be celebrating 4 years of sobriety. I moved into Many Mansions, and I thank God because I am so grateful to be able to start my life over again. And if I can do it, anyone can!
