Vicky, a child of immigrant parents from Spain, loved school and education, but due to economic and family situations, she only attained a 4<sup>th</sup> grade education.



Although she could never attain her goal to be a teacher, she fulfilled part of her goal by spending most of her life as an elementary school teacher's aide. Her love of children and her bi-lingual skills enabled her to work well into her mid-80's. This diminutive woman had an enormous impact on her students, primarily because she cared deeply for each child. She had the innate ability to build positive self-esteem regardless of a child's handicap or family situation.

The testimonials from adults who remembered the impact Vicky made on their lives during their formative years is the inspiration for this scholarship. These guidelines and the attached application form will be helpful in determining your eligibility and outlining the application process.

# Vicky's Scholarship Fund

## Guidelines and Application Information

### Eligible applicants

1. A resident of a property owned or managed by Many Mansions
  - a. A senior graduating from high school this year or a current college student.
  - b. An incoming or current student in an accredited technical school or post high school educational program
  - c. An adult seeking a GED certificate
  - d. Previous Vicky's Scholarship Fund winners who continue to meet these criteria
2. Applicants younger than 18 need to have the signature of a parent or guardian on the application.

### Acceptable uses of the scholarship award

1. Tuition and other school fees
2. Books, supplies and/or materials
3. Professional tutoring, preparatory fees, pre-admittance testing (e.g. SAT test fees or review classes)
4. Other school related expenses

### Disbursement of funds

Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the appropriate institution or educational service.
